A new CFRA Membership Dues Structure will launch in **January 2026**. Existing and new members will receive details to support a smooth transition over the next six months

CFRA's new membership dues structure, launching in January 2026, is designed to support the following goals:

- Expand access to CFRA membership for individual Family Resource Centers (FRCs), both within and outside of networks
- Promote greater participation in the National Family Support Network Standards of Quality for Family Strengthening and Support
- Support professional development opportunities for students pursuing careers in family strengthening
- Increase community engagement and representation across the state
- Sustain and strengthen statewide policy and advocacy efforts
